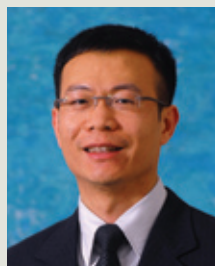
other aspects of human resources, in consulting and corporate roles across Asia and Australia.
