Prizes:

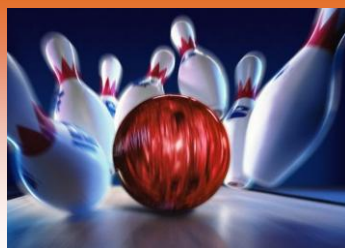
- Champion, 1st Runner-Up and 2nd Runner-up for **each grade**.
