ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Mr. Clement CHEUNG started his career in the Hong Kong Civil Service as an Administrative Officer in 1983 and was closely involved with formulation of government policies on hospital services, public housing as well as trade and investment promotion. Before joining the former Works Bureau which has evolved into the Environment, Transport and Works Bureau, Mr Cheung was Director of the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in Singapore responsible for ASEAN regional affairs. He assumed duty as Deputy Secretary for Environment, Transport and Works in 2001 and was initially assigned with the task of implementing recommendations made by the Construction Industry Review Committee. His portfolio has since been expanded to cover management of the Public Works Programme with an average annual expenditure of \$29 billion, greening strategies and initiatives, as well as organizational reforms and resource planning for the Works Departments. He took up his present appointment as Commissioner of Insurance in July 2006.

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The recent crisis has exposed some structural weaknesses in the global financial system, with issues such as identification and mitigation of systematic risks, avoidance of pro-cyclical behaviour, strengthening of enterprise risk management, supervision of unregulated entities as well as valuation of assets and liabilities at the forefront of international deliberations.

From a regulatory viewpoint, adoption of more sophisticated and risk sensitive supervisory frameworks, group supervision and cross-border cooperation, enhanced information disclosure and consumer protection are attracting a great deal of interest and attention. Meanwhile, increasing efforts are being directed towards elevating the level of adherence to international standards through capacity building to reduce the scope for arbitrage. For insurers, a major challenge remains on how to modify their product mix to meet changing consumer demands and assist their frontline staff in adapting to new compliance requirements.

This seminar will provide a brief analysis of key factors leading to the financial tsunami, outline relevant observations and experience gained from coping with this unprecedented debacle and offer an outlook for the insurance industry from a regulatory and operational perspective.
