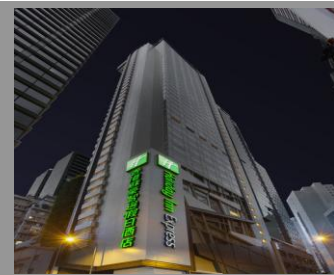

ABOUT THE VISIT

Holiday Inn Express Hong Kong Soho (Holiday Inn) is the first commercial high-rise building in the world to achieve four platinum or equivalent Green Awards:

- (1) [BEAM \(Building Environmental Assessment Method\) Plus – New Building](#) (the first BEAM Plus Platinum rating building)
- (2) *LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environment Design) new construction by US Green Building Council*
- (3) *BCA Green Mark Platinum Provisional*
- (4) *China Green Building Council – Three Star*

Holiday Inn is the flagship of green building with a number of innovative ideas on Energy Optimization Solutions (EOS) and sustainable practices. Being the hotel project obtaining Platinum grading under the BEAM Plus assessment, the design and construction of the hotel building is “Green” concerned and oriented on sustainability, water efficiency, energy and atmosphere optimization, material and resources consideration, indoor environmental quality performance and control as well as design innovative. Under projection and comparing to hotels of same scale, overall energy saving and reduction of CO₂ emission of Holiday Inn is about 60% and 70% respectively.

During the visit, Ir Antonio Chan will share his experience on the green and innovative ideas adopted in this project such as the EOS to the heating, ventilation and air conditioning system, adoption of intelligent permanent magnet motor fan coil unit, chilled headboard, 18-meter vertical exterior green wall, green rooftop, rain water recycling system, intelligent room roller blind control of reducing solar heat gain, pattern recognition energy saving solution in common area, etc. It is then followed by a tour to the guestrooms floor, equipment rooms, the podium and the roof.
