Professor Katherine Schipper

Professor, Duke University

Prof. Schipper is Thomas F. Keller Professor of Accounting at the Fuqua School of Business, Duke University. She completed her role as a Board Member at the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) in June 2006. She sits on the editorial boards of several leading journals.

Prof. Schipper was named to the Accounting Hall of Fame in 2007 and was the first woman to be inducted.

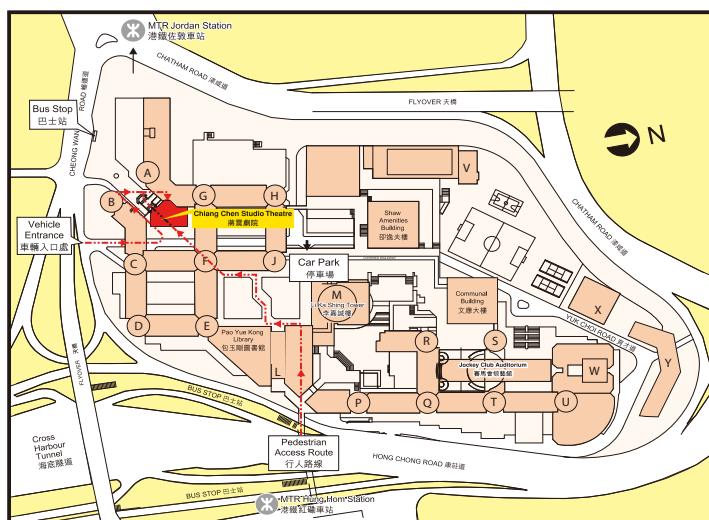
Prof. Schipper has published research papers on a wide range of accounting disciplines in top journals and has been the recipient of several grants and awards, including the American Accounting Association Outstanding Educator. She has served as the President and as the Director of Research of the American Accounting Association. She was a member of the FASB Financial Accounting Standards Advisory Council (FASAC) from 1996 to 1999.

Professor Ross L. Watts

Massachusetts Institute of Technology

Prof. Watts is a professor of accounting at Sloan School of Management of Massachusetts Institute of Technology. His book, co-authored with Professor Zimmerman - Positive Accounting Theory - has been used in PhD programmes in accounting for 20 years. Prof. Watts has published extensively in leading accounting and finance journals.

Prof. Watts is the founding editor of the Journal of Accounting & Economics. He was awarded the American Accounting Association's Seminal Contributions to Accounting Literature Award in 2004 and the Outstanding Accounting Educator Award in 2000. His recent research interests are accounting conservatism, value-relevance, accounting accrual process, relationship between accounting numbers and stock prices, corporate financial and compensation policy, lawsuits against audit firms, and the internal organization of firms.
