About the Speaker

The Honourable Mr. Justice Barma was born in India in 1959. After obtaining the degrees of Bachelor of Arts (Jurisprudence) and Bachelor of Civil Law from the University of Oxford in 1981 and 1982 respectively, he was called to the Bar in both Hong Kong and in England and Wales (Middle Temple) in 1983. He was admitted as an Advocate and Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Singapore in 1991. He was in private practice at the Hong Kong Bar from 1985 to 2003, and was appointed as Senior Counsel in Hong Kong in 2002. He was appointed by the Hong Kong Judiciary to be a Deputy Judge of the Court of First Instance of the High Court for periods in 2002 and 2003 respectively. In 2003, he was appointed as a Judge of the Court of First Instance of the High Court of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, where the majority of his work is in the fields of company and corporate and personal insolvency law.
