Students of ICAEW should note that you are required to complete its education, training and examination programme, become a full member of the institute before you can be admitted as a member of the Hong Kong Institute of CPAs under the Membership and Co-operation Agreement.

Members of other accountancy bodies who joined ICAEW by virtue of ICAEW's reciprocal membership arrangements with another body or through the ICAEW Pathways to Membership programme are not eligible to apply for HKICPA membership under the MCA.
